PRESIDENTS' MESSAGE

UNITY

"I don't need you to agree with me, I need you to care about me!" – Rabbi Jonathan Sacks

As our country struggles with very important decisions, we feel a need for unification and support for human dignity. This is not a judgment, it is an observation.

It seems like our synagogue needs the same thing and I see that we have retained our sense of unity and support human dignity.

What do we mean by that? Sometimes we feel alone as we struggle to hold our temple together. We work diligently every day to make sure that things get done. Since some of you live far away, you don't see the difficulties that we face every day. You assume that things are just fine. However, when we ask for help, many of you come through.

As you saw in our Shofar, our building is leaking from all sides. Although this is not a new "problem," it persists and we are helpless to its insidious drain on our nerves.

We want to thank those of you who have decided that you feel strongly about our synagogue and, therefore, decided to contribute to our very expensive endeavor.

You don't have to agree with us, just care about us and our beloved Temple Emanu-El.

RABBI'S MESSAGE

And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you the power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore to your fathers, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 8:18

We are told clearly in the Torah, that wealth is necessary to the purposes of G-d. The *Pasuk* (verse) above is a very lucid statement of this necessity for G-d's purposes and His will to be done. He gives us the *power to get wealth*. The obvious question is why then are so many of G-d's people not the people with wealth and influence?

We just read in our *Parasha that* Abraham's wife was barren, and, so too, were Isaac's and Jacob's wives but why? We find the answer in Go-d's purposes, The verse in Deuteronomy says "the power to get wealth" the Hebrew word is ASAH, which has several meanings, including, that which is produced or brought forth (Gen 1:11) from a seed. Everything G-d does is with a seed; babies, lions, whales, trees, eagles, even tiny gnats start from a seed. G-d too, can give us an idea, concepts or wisdom, so that we become his womb to bring forth a yield or harvest. The "power to get wealth" is from a seed in us or those near us. It is something we conceive, carry to full term with a fierce faith.

Many people are waiting for G-d to give them wealth; he does not give wealth, he gives us the "power to get wealth" We have to take the seed of power and produce wealth with it with faith.

Instead of turning to G-d, people trust in their minds, hearts or others. I see this is an endemic problem. Therefore, they do not recognize G-d's giving as Jeremiah 17:5-6 tells us and what the sad result is Thus says the Lord: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man

And makes flesh his strength

And makes flesh his strength, Whose heart departs from the Lord. For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes But shall inhabit parched places in the wilderness,

When we trust in our own abilities or people even princes and our heart is not depending on G-d, we become like a shrub in the desert, we inhabit parched places, we miss the good. Don't be one who missed the good, turn to the Lord and repent. Then we will see a new light, intact many new lights that chases much of the world's darkness away. Hannukah reminds us of this possibility of always overcoming the darkness, A Happy Freilich Hannukah to you and your family.
