RABBI'S MESSAGE

Footsteps of the Messiah

According to an eyewitness, 40 years ago Rabbi Yitchak Kaduri, the most famous Kabbalist in Israel, predicted that the Messiah will be revealed following an election stalemate. At a small gathering, Rabbi Kaduri was asked when the Messiah will come. He answered, 'When there will be elections but there will not be a government" - which made no sense then. G-d is not giving up on a humanity that insists on making men take G-d's rightful position. What we are really witnessing is the hidden and supernatural compassion of the truly infinite Almighty in this novel plague sweeping Wuhan, China and the world, Blessed be his name.

The Two most devastating flu pandemics of the 20th century — <u>Asian flu of 1957</u> and <u>Hong Kong flu of 1968</u> — originated in China. In 2003 SARS, killed 774 people, nearly all in mainland China. A Deadly 1997 bird flu, in 2019 half of China's pigs wiped out by a virus that causes African swine fever, H7N9, which spread in China in 2013...now in 2020 the Wuhan Covid19.

Why China? My belief is that ever since China has adopted a policy of official state atheism, it is chosen to set an example to its people and the world. In April 2016, the General Secretary, Xi Jinping, stated that members of the Communist Party of China CCP must be "unyielding Marxist Atheists" while in the same month, a government demolition work crew drove a bulldozer over two Chinese Christians who protested the demolition of their beloved church by refusing to step aside. Perhaps a compassionate G-d is showing he has not given up on us and has been sending help yet again with another opportunity to an ancient society that it could re-examine its government – which is but an old human condition that has usurped to itself the role of G-d; Perhaps all humanity can learn and benefit by turning from this false, cruel god to the one true, loving, everlasting G-d.

King Solomon in his book of Proverbs states "He that walks with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed." (Proverbs 13:20) Our tradition repeatedly insists there is only one true One ,who can properly govern our minds, hearts and souls, so that man's decisions and actions do not destroy or hurt

The Bottom Line

What is G-d's Torah instruction here? 1. Do not be a companion of fools who see themselves as above god 2. Fear the Lord and it shall be well with thee – be humble = repent and return to the one true Lord. The #1 recommendation: Take G-d's medicine – The great prayer of Protection – pray Psalm 91 everyday, morning and eve, and experience a G-d that invites us to abide and find shelter with him - May he be Glorified forever and ever. Amen.

Passover Emanu-El 5780-2020 Mechirat Hametz Form - The Sale of Hametz Leaven

(Pesach), commemorates the story of the Exodus, and the Israelites' freedom from slavery in Egypt. Passover begins on the 15th day of the month of Nisan in the Jewish calendar and is celebrated for eight days.

The children of Israel are forbidden to own any type of hametz,(leaven) during Pesach from Wednesday, April 8, until sunset of Thursday, April 16, 2020. The form below authorizes Temple Emanu-El's Rabbi Jacob Benzaquen to act as an agent for the sale of hametz to a non-Jew. The hametz is stored away until after the Pesach holiday.
